

POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

CATEGORY	GUIDELINE
Format & Display	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Digital format</i> • <i>Displayed in designated area</i> • <i>Must follow session schedule for mounting and removal</i>
Size & Orientation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>2 meters x 4 meters</i> • <i>Portrait orientation</i>
Content Focus	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Emphasize scientific content over aesthetic design</i> • <i>Content must clearly relate to the event theme</i> • <i>Logical flow: Introduction to Recommendation</i>
Language Use	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Use clear, concise, plain language</i> • <i>Prefer short sentences and bullet points</i> • <i>Avoid technical jargon and abbreviations</i>
Visual Elements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Use charts and images to aid understanding</i> • <i>Visuals must be clear, self-explanatory, and central to the message</i>
Font & Readability	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Use Sans-Serif fonts (e.g., Arial)</i> • <i>Minimum font size: 24 pt</i> • <i>Text must be legible from 2 meters</i>
Presenter's Role	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Presenter must be present during the assigned time</i> • <i>Engage and discuss the poster with viewers</i>
File Format	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Acceptable formats: TIFF, EPS, PDF, MS Office files</i>
Poster Composition	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>All text and labels must be embedded in the image file</i> • <i>Do not submit separate outlines or synopses</i> • <i>Avoid excessive white space or "Poster Presentation" headers</i>
